

PEER REVIEW QUESTIONS

- Cultural diversity becomes a valued resource in the context of globalization. **Our different angles of observation that come from our different social locations can provide insights on the global changes underway.** When we effectively communicate how we see the world, this process of communication can not only facilitate mutual understanding but also, offer the potential for social change (Sorrells 2012). By sharing observations on each other's photos you are providing a different angle of observation to the other teams.

 - Using our different angles of observation, when you review this photo how well does this photograph represent evidence of global connection to another part of the world?

 - Do you see a connection between this photo and the team's guiding question?

- Obvious versus not so obvious global connections:** The following questions were posed by one scholar to test **the extent to which connectedness** exists throughout the world (Martell 2010):

 - * Is there a contribution from all places in the world or only certain regions?
 - * Is daily life just interconnected or is daily interdependent?
 - * Are these global connections stable and regular - or do the connections occur once in awhile?
 - * Are all groups within the neighborhood globally connected or is it just a few?
 - * Do the people in the neighborhood seem to be aware of their global connections?
 - Does the photograph highlight an obvious example of globalization? Explain.

 - What about a not so obvious example, with captions explaining the connection?

- 3. Strong photos versus weak photos.** Rather than taking a snapshot, your goal is to make a photograph that conveys your intended message about globalization. Strong photographs frame the subject of analysis by taking advantage of composition. Strong photographs highlight the intended focal point using techniques such as angle and light. In the process of making photographs, be sure that you follow ethical guidelines established during class.

 - As a viewer, the main point or message of this photograph is clear.
 - Photographs taken and selected for the photo essay demonstrate an ethical sensitivity to the people who appear in the photos.
